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## Supplies needed

**tension device**

**grommet anchor** made of bead and crochet thread

**cord to put through anchor**

**flat mesh sticks:** 1/4"

**netting needle or shuttle**

**scissors**

**size 80 tatting thread or size 12 perle cotton:** 10 yards

**1/8" wide ribbon:** 12 inches

**60 mm ornament ball** (7.25 inch circumference): 1

# Rick-rack Stitch Ball Cover

414 knots in this ball cover

## Instructions

Tie a connecting knot (CK) at the end of each round to form the last loop of that round.

### Lily Center

#### Round 1

1/4" flat mesh stick

Form a grommet with 18 loops, the last one tied by hand with a connecting knot (CK). (26 loops in the round)

#### Round 2

1/4" flat mesh stick

Net 1 knot in each loop. (18 loops in the round)

### Rickrack Decorative Stitch

#### Round 3

1/4" flat mesh stick

Net 2 more knots in the loop formed by the CK, net 3 knots in all other loops. (54 loops in the round)

#### Round 4

1/4" flat mesh stick

Net together the loop formed by the CK, the loop to the right of the CK and the loop to the left of the CK (total 3 loops) without the mesh stick, now with the mesh stick \*net 3 loops together\*; repeat from \* to \*. (18 loops in the round)

#### Round 5

1/4" flat mesh stick

Net 2 more knots in the loop formed by the CK, net 3 knots in all other loops. (54 loops in the round)

#### Round 6

1/4" flat mesh stick

Net together the loop formed by the CK, the loop to the right of the CK and the loop to the left of the CK (total 3 loops) without the mesh stick, now with the mesh stick \*net 3 loops together\*; repeat from \* to \*. (18 loops in the round)

#### Round 7

1/4" flat mesh stick

Net 2 more knots in the loop formed by the CK, net 3 knots in all other loops. (54 loops in the round)

### Round 8

1/4" flat mesh stick

Net together the loop formed by the CK, the loop to the right of the CK and the loop to the left of the CK (total 3 loops) without the mesh stick, now with the mesh stick \*net 3 loops together\*; repeat from \* to \*. (18 loops in the round)

### Round 9

1/4" flat mesh stick

Net 2 more knots in the loop formed by the CK, net 3 knots in all other loops. (54 loops in the round)

### Round 10

1/4" flat mesh stick

Net together the loop formed by the CK, the loop to the right of the CK and the loop to the left of the CK (total 3 loops) without the mesh stick, now with the mesh stick \*net 3 loops together\*; repeat from \* to \*. (18 loops in the round)

### Round 11

1/4" flat mesh stick

Net 2 more knots in the loop formed by the CK, net 3 knots in all other loops. (54 loops in the round)

### Round 12

1/4" flat mesh stick

Net together the loop formed by the CK, the loop to the right of the CK and the loop to the left of the CK (total 3 loops) without the mesh stick, now with the mesh stick \*net 3 loops together\*; repeat from \* to \*. (18 loops in the round)

### Round 13

1/4" flat mesh stick

Net 1 knot in each loop. (18 loops in the round)

## Finishing the Ball

1. Place ball into net.
2. Weave 1/8" ribbon through each loop in final round.
3. Pull the ribbon tightly around the ball and tie in place.
